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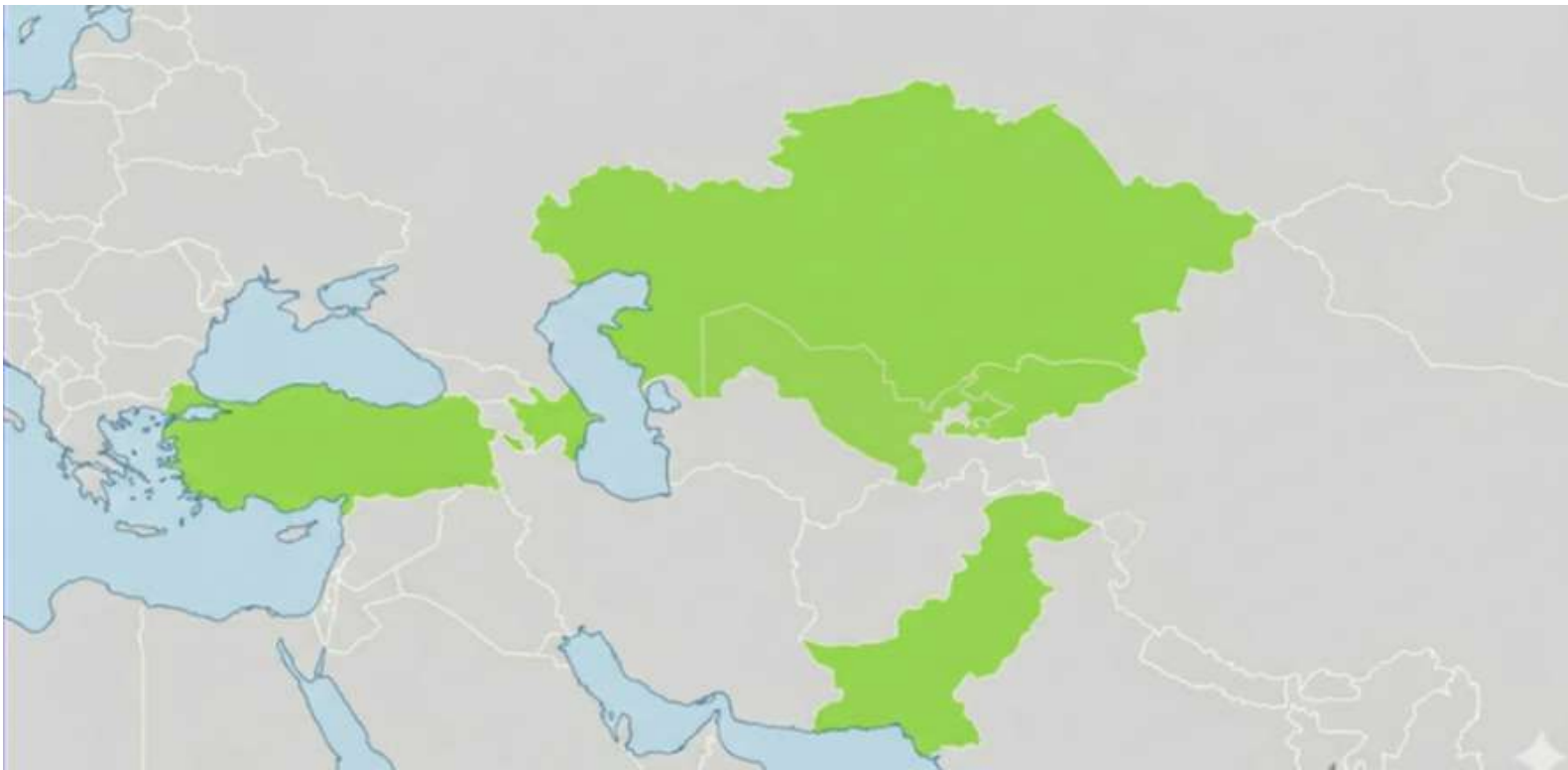

Executive Summary



From April to June 2026, the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) Clean Energy Centre (CECECO) further strengthened its position as a regional hub for renewable energy, energy efficiency, and sustainable development by reinforcing its organizational framework and broadening partnerships across the region and beyond.

During the reporting period, CECECO's legal foundation was further consolidated following approval of the Host Country Agreement. The First Meeting of the Executive Board of CECECO was convened with the attendance of representatives of all Signatory States.

The Centre also continued its active engagement in the Global Network of Regional Sustainable Energy Centres (GN-SEC). CECECO signed the Memorandum of Understanding with the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), paving the way for future result-oriented endeavors.

The Centre will continue to foster regional collaboration, expand strategic partnerships, encourage innovation and knowledge exchange, and support sustainable energy initiatives that contribute to a more resilient, energy-efficient, and interconnected ECO region.

Institutional Setup & Governance

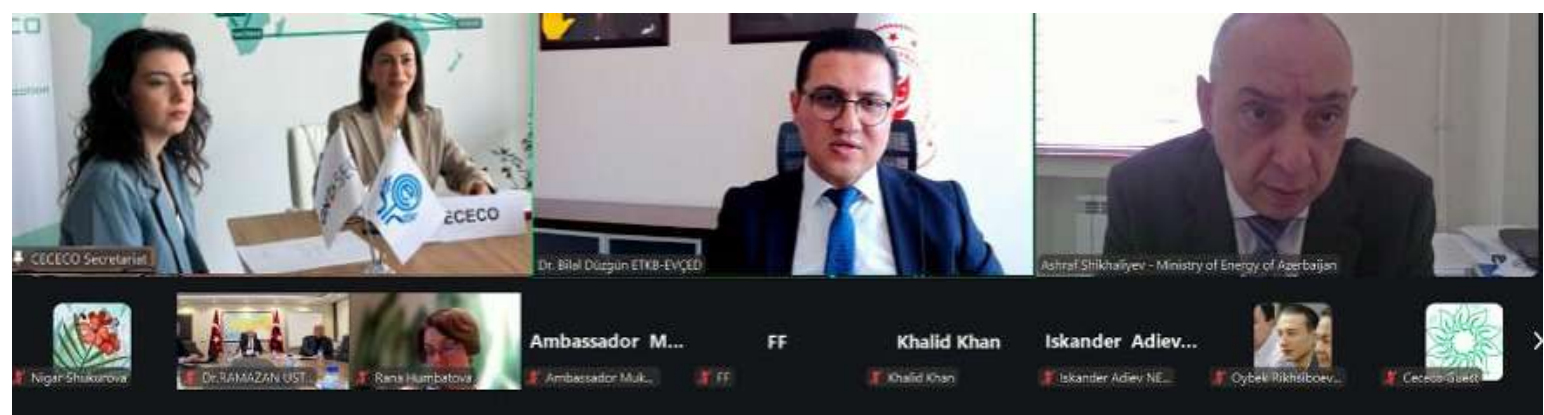
Approval of the Host Country Agreement

On 27 April 2026, the Milli Majlis (Parliament) of the Republic of Azerbaijan approved the Host Country Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Economic Cooperation Organization Clean Energy Centre (CECECO), signed in Baku on 2 December 2025. On the same day, the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, H.E. Mr. Ilham Aliyev, signed the Law approving the Agreement, which establishes the legal framework for CECECO's operations as a regional clean energy centre headquartered in Azerbaijan.

First Meeting of the Executive Board

The meeting of the Executive Board of CECECO was held virtually on 14 May 2026 under the Chairmanship of the Republic of Azerbaijan and brought together representatives of CECECO Signatory States, the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) Secretariat, and the CECECO Secretariat.

The Executive Board reviewed the Centre's progress since its operationalization and supported its activities following discussions on the proposed Work Plan for May–December 2026. Members also reviewed key institutional documents, including the draft Staff and Financial Regulations, and discussed the establishment of the CECECO Distinction Award as a regional framework to recognize achievements in renewable energy and energy efficiency. The meeting further highlighted preparations for future regional initiatives and CECECO's engagement in COP31 in the Republic of Türkiye.



CECECO Internship Programme

To support capacity-building and youth engagement, CECECO launched its Internship Programme, providing university students and young professionals with practical experience in research, communications, and project coordination. During the reporting period, two interns completed the programme, while four new interns joined the Secretariat, who are currently supporting its ongoing activities.



Meetings

Meeting with H.E. Mr. Parviz Shahbazov



CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova was received by H.E. Mr. Parviz Shahbazov, Minister of Energy of the Republic of Azerbaijan. Discussions focused on CECECO's activities as a regional cooperation platform and its ongoing and planned projects. Ms. Yagubova also presented information on the Centre's planned Regional Clean Energy Compendium—a centralized compilation of existing national renewable energy and energy efficiency legislation, regulatory acts, and policy frameworks across the ECO Member States. She noted that the initiative would serve as a valuable resource for investors, financial institutions, and other stakeholders.

She further outlined CECECO's plans to strengthen knowledge and capacity-building, promote the exchange of experience among member countries, and expand participation in regional and international forums.

Meeting with H.E. Mr. Mukhtar Babayev

CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova paid a courtesy call on H.E. Mr. Mukhtar Babayev, Representative of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan on Climate Issues. During the meeting, Ms. Yagubova presented an overview of CECECO's activities and upcoming projects, while exchanging views on renewable energy, energy efficiency, and opportunities for collaboration in support of climate and sustainable development priorities.



Meeting with Mr. Samir Akhundov



CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova met with Mr. Samir Akhundov, Chairman of the Board of the Azerbaijan Energy Regulatory Agency (AERA). Discussions addressed CECECO's activities and potential areas of cooperation in renewable energy and energy efficiency, including possible collaboration with the support of Energy Efficiency Fund.

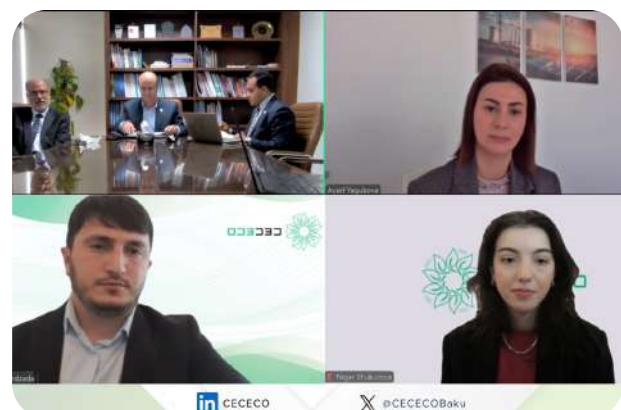
Meeting with COP29 high-level champion

The parties exchanged views on institutional cooperation, research activities, knowledge sharing, and regional partnerships in renewable energy, sustainability, and the energy transition, while considering potential joint initiatives across the ECO region.

Clean Energy Innovation and Regional Cooperation: Scaling Solutions for a Sustainable Future



Within the framework of Baku Energy Week 2026, CECECO organized a special session on "Clean Energy Innovation and Regional Cooperation: Scaling Solutions for a Sustainable Future" on 2 June 2026.

The session focused on enabling ecosystems, financing mechanisms, and regional cooperation to accelerate the development and deployment of clean energy innovations. At the opening of the session, the CECECO Executive Director emphasized the importance of supportive policies, access to finance, and regional partnerships in advancing clean energy solutions.

Keynote addresses were delivered by Mr. Francesco La Camera, Director-General of the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), and Dr. Elnur Soltanov, Deputy Minister of Energy of the Republic of Azerbaijan. Moderated by Mr. Fariz Ismayilzade, Member of the Parliament and vice-rector of ADA University, the panel discussion featured representatives of Pakistan, SOCAR Green, bp Azerbaijan, UNIDO, and the Asian Development Bank. The speakers presented perspectives on investment priorities, emerging technologies, and practical approaches to advancing clean energy projects.

Vienna, Austria – April, 2026

International Conference “Clean Hydrogen: Shaping Sustainable Industry’s Future”

The CECECO delegation attended the conference ‘Clean Hydrogen: Shaping Sustainable Industry’s Future’, hosted by UNIDO in collaboration with its international partners, in Vienna on 8 April 2026. The conference focused on advancing sustainable industrialization through clean hydrogen, fostering dialogue among policymakers, industry leaders, and international partners, and exploring solutions for decarbonizing key sectors in developing and transition economies.



8th Steering Committee Meeting of the UNIDO Global Network of Regional Sustainable Energy Centres

CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova joined colleagues from the UNIDO Global Network of Regional Sustainable Energy Centres for the 8th Steering Committee meeting. The discussions focused on collective progress, strategic priorities, platform services, programme development, partnerships, and financing opportunities to strengthen the network and advance a just energy transition across regions.

International Vienna Energy and Climate Forum 2026

CECECO representatives participated in the International Vienna Energy and Climate Forum, held in Vienna, Austria.



At Plenary 2 “From Commitment to Action: Global Green Industrialization as a Pillar of Prosperity for All,” CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova highlighted the importance of strengthening regional knowledge and data ecosystems to support transparency and evidence-based decision-making across the ECO region.

Ms. Yagubova delivered remarks at the roundtable on “Green Industrial Corridors and Sustainable Regional Value Chains.” She underlined the importance of integrating renewable energy deployment with cross-border infrastructure and industrial planning, noting the potential of green energy corridors to transform landlocked countries into connectivity hubs and strengthen regional value chains.



Ms. Yagubova also spoke at the IVECF 2026 side event “Regional Initiatives to Enabling Energy Efficient Cooling: The Case Study of Africa.” Drawing on the African experience, she emphasized the relevance of regional harmonization of efficiency standards, robust testing and certification systems, and integrated approaches combining policy with market incentives for the ECO region.

Supporting Young Clean Energy Innovators

Mr. Elgun Rzayev, one of the winners of the CECECO Clean Energy Hackathon with the project Weather-Sync Smart Heat, participated in Cleantech Days and the IVCEF 2026. He presented his project and participated in thematic sessions and networking activities with entrepreneurs, mentors, and innovation experts, gaining exposure to international cleantech innovation and entrepreneurship.

Meeting with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)

The parties also exchanged views on opportunities to further promote CECECO's engagement with international partners.

Central Asia Regional Ecological Summit 2026

Upon the invitation of H.E. Mr. Yerlan Nyssanbayev, Minister of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Republic of Kazakhstan, CECECO representatives participated in the Central Asia Regional Ecological Summit 2026, held in Astana, Kazakhstan, which brought together government representatives, international organizations, development partners, and experts to discuss environmental protection, climate action, and sustainable development in Central Asia.

Accelerating Green and Low-Carbon Industrialization in Central Asia

Ms. Aysel Yagubova spoke at the session, highlighting the region's potential for green industrial transformation and emphasizing the importance of cooperation, investment, and institutional support in advancing the energy transition. She also presented CECECO's activities in technical cooperation, capacity-building, and project implementation.



ECO High-Level Dialogue Platform on Environmental Cooperation

CECECO representatives attended the First Meeting of the High-Level Dialogue Platform on Environmental Cooperation (HLDP) within the framework of the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO). The HLDPE meeting formally inaugurated a new interactive consultation mechanism for ECO Member States to exchange perspectives on shared environmental challenges, including pollution, biodiversity loss, and the adverse impacts of climate change.

The meeting brought together senior environment officials from ECO Member States in a hybrid highlevel roundtable. Participants identified priority thematic areas for continued dialogue, including transboundary air pollution, climate adaptation, biodiversity conservation, and circular economy approaches.

The delegation included more than 150 ambassadors, diplomats, military attachés, and representatives of international organizations from 62 countries.

The two-day visit included Khankendi and the districts of Khojaly, Shusha (ECO Tourism Capital 2026), and Lachin, providing participants with an overview of ongoing reconstruction, development, and regional cooperation initiatives.



Dubrovnik, Croatia – June, 2026

CECECO Executive Director Ms. Aysel Yagubova participated in the regional presentation of UNIDO's Industrial Development Report 2026 on the sidelines of the Dubrovnik Forum. The event featured the launch of the Eastern Europe and Central Asia regional chapter of the report and focused on the implications of global industrial megatrends for competitiveness and sustainable industrial development in the region.

During the panel, Ms. Yagubova emphasized the significant renewable energy potential of Central Asia and its contribution to value creation and low-carbon industrialization. She also presented CECECO's work within the UNIDO Global Network of Regional Sustainable Energy Centres (GN-SEC) in promoting renewable energy, energy efficiency, South–South cooperation, and regional knowledge exchange.

Capacity Building for the National Hydrogen Strategy – Advanced Engineering and Market Analysis

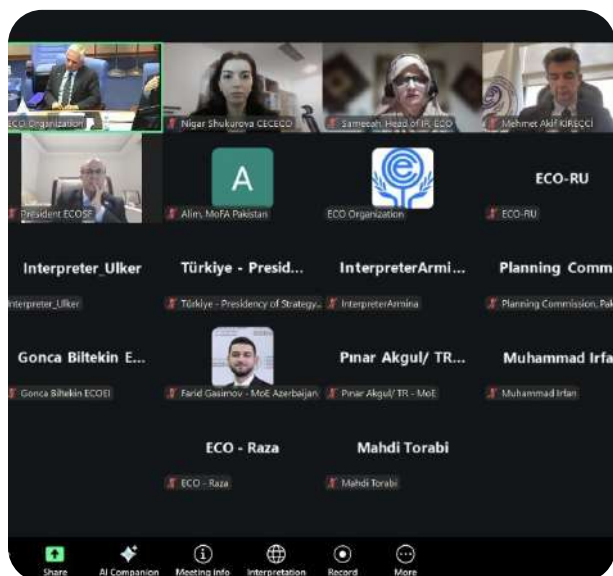
International Conference "Human Capital Formation for Sustainable and Resilient Urban Development"

Side Event on Decarbonizing Housing and Buildings

Memorandum of Understanding with the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA)

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) and the Economic Cooperation Organization Clean Energy Centre (CECECO) on the sidelines of the Baku Energy Forum 2026. The MoU was signed by Mr. Francesco La Camera, Director-General of IRENA, and Ms. Aysel Yagubova, Executive Director of CECECO.



The Memorandum establishes a framework for cooperation in renewable energy and sustainable development, covering energy infrastructure, green industrialization, capacity-building, and the exchange of knowledge and experience on renewable energy policies, institutional development, and regulatory frameworks.

IRENA is the leading intergovernmental organization supporting the global transition to renewable energy through policy advice, technical expertise, and international cooperation.

Supporting Partner of the 16th Dii Desert Energy Leadership Summit

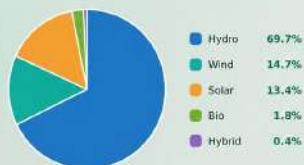

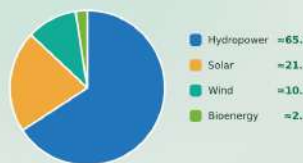

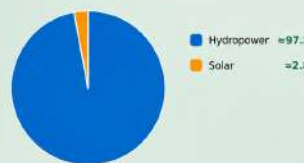
